Construction of Bristol Road roundabout starts July 6 in Genesee County

COUNTY:

Genesee

HIGHWAY:

I-75/Bristol Road

PROJECT:

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest \$3 million constructing a roundabout on Bristol Road, adjacent to the northbound I-75 ramps and General Motors plant entrance. This project includes additional intersection upgrades and signal work intended to improve safety for motorists and mitigate congestion.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS:

Traffic on Bristol Road and the ramps to and from I-75 will be maintained with lane closures and traffic shifts. Beginning July 6, crews will complete pavement repairs on Bristol Road and the ramps between Torrey and Van Slyke roads.

Following temporary pavement work, crews will construct the south section of the roundabout and lanes (pictured in the attached graphic, Roundabout Construction – Phase 2). Additional phases of construction and their intended traffic impact will be shared as the project progresses.
