Leaf Vacuum Schedule

Emterra will start their leaf vacuum in several subdivisions on November 2 and run through the month of November. Signs will be placed on Friday the week prior for the affected subdivision. The schedule is as follows:

- **Nov 2 - Nov 6 : Zone 2** which includes Jaclyn Ann, Jamie Lynn, Wesley, Applewood, Apple Blossom, Spy Dell, Woodridge, Ambleside, Fountain View, Shady Brook, Misty Morning, Bending Brook, Falling Leaf, Longview, Cornerstone, Woodvalley, Tim Tam, Gallant Fox and Nashua.
- **Nov 9- Nov 13 : Zone 1** which includes Twin Oaks, all of Ponderosa Subdivision and Granrich Heights Subdivision.
- **Nov 16 - 20 : Zone 2**
- **Nov 23 - 27 : Zone 1**

Please don't rake leaves after the trucks have driven by, they normally won't be back around for a couple weeks. The Road Commission is asking once again that you do not rake leaves into the street. It is dangerous and plugs up the drains.

Election Information

Our Clerk and staff have been working very hard this summer, after receiving a record number of Absentee Ballots. **The Presidential Election is Tuesday, November 3.** To aid in this process, we are closing the office to all business except for the election. Special election business hours are Saturday, October 31 from 8am to 4pm, Monday from 8am to 4pm and Tuesday, November 3 from 7 am to 8 pm, all normal polling locations will be open from 7 am to 8 pm for in person voting. The last day to receive an absentee ballot is Monday, November 2nd by 4 pm.

The township will resume regular business on Wednesday, November 4.

Road Improvements

A lot of road repairs were completed this year. Potter Rd was paved from Elms Rd to M-13 (6 miles) and the cost was shared between Flushing Twp and Clayton Twp. Francis Rd was chip sealed and fog sealed from Elms Rd to McKinley Rd and that cost was split with Montrose Twp. Johnson Rd from Mt.Morris to Stanley Rds was repaved and from Coldwater to the end received new limestone. In addition, limestone was added to Duff Rd. and Morrish from Frances to Mt.Morris Rds. No big road improvement projects are scheduled for next year.
